Daily Itinerary

DAY 1 March 15: FLIGHT TO ATHENS, GREECE

Your pilgrimage begins today by boarding your flight to Athens. As Airfare is not include in this tour each passenger will make their own air travel arrangements.

DAY 2 March 16: ARRIVE IN ATHENS

After arriving in Athens, you will transfer yourself to the hotel. This is your first night hotel stay. You are free to use the remainder of the day exploring Athens - overnight at your hotel in Athens.

DAY 3 March 17: ATHENS / DELPHI / KALAMBAKA

This morning, we will arrive in Piraeus. We begin by driving along the national highway through Thebes, Levadia, and Arachova to Delphi. We will visit the Delphi Museum, which holds the famous Bronze Charioteer, along with other famous Greek statues. This afternoon, we will visit the Temple of Apollo, the Theatre, the Athenian Treasury, and the Castilian Spring. Finally, we will make the drive through Larissa, Lamia, and Trikala to Kalambaka—dinner & overnight at your hotel.

DAY 4 March 18: KALAMBAKA / THESSALONIKI

Our first stop today will be Meteora to see the "Hanging Monasteries" perched on top of incredible and unusual rock formations. Next, we will drive through Kozani to Veria, and then on to visit the tomb of Philip of Macedonia in Vergina. We will continue via Edessa to Thessaloniki, where you will see the Rotonda, the Triumphal Arch of Galerius, and the White Tower along the seafront promenade—dinner & overnight at your hotel in Thessaloniki.

DAY 5 March 19: THESSALONIKI / PHILIPPI / THESSALONIKI

After breakfast, we will drive to Amphipholis, where you will see the famous Lion Statue. Next, we will continue to Philippi, where Marc Anthony defeated Brutus, and St. Paul first preached the Gospel in Europe. We will also visit the Roman Forum, the ruins of two Basilicas, the theatre, St. Paul's prison, and St. Lydia's Baptistry. Afterward, we will visit Kavala before returning to Thessaloniki for the night—dinner & overnight at your hotel.

DAY 6 March 20: THESSALONIKI / ATHENS

This morning, we will return to Athens via the Valley of Tempi and Thermopylae—dinner & overnight at your hotel.

DAY 7 March 21: ATHENS / CORINTH

After breakfast, we will drive along the Sacred Way of Eleusinian Mysteries, passing the Island of Salamis. We will then cross the Corinth Canal, which connects the Aegean and Ionian Seas, into Corinth. Arguably the most significant city in the days of St. Paul, the mostly Gentile Church he founded here in 50 AD caused him much grief and prompted him to write at least four letters to the Corinthians. St. Paul worked here with Aquila and Priscilla and was tried by the Roman Senator Gallio in the agora. See the remains of first-century shops, the Fountain of Peirene, the Temple of Apollo, and the Bema. Afterward, we will return to Athens for a city tour that will include:

- · The Royal Palace
- · The Stadium and Temple of Zeus
- The Theatre of Dionysius
- · Mars Hill
- · The Acropolis & Parthenon
- · Socrates' prison

Tonight's dinner will be at a local restaurant—overnight at your hotel.

DAY 8 March 22: ATHENS / PIRAEUS / CRUISE TO MYKONOS

After breakfast, we embark on a cruise through the Greek Isles with the enrapturing scenery of Island beaches, warm sun, and blue sea. Our first island destination will be Mykonos, where we will have time to explore this charming town filled with wonderful restaurants, shops, and old-world appeal. Don't forget to set aside time to see the magnificent sunset before sailing to Ephesus—dinner & overnight onboard the ship.

DAY 9 March 23: KUSADASI, TURKEY & PATMOS, GREECE

We begin our day at Mt. Koressos. Tucked away in a small valley, it's possible Mary the mother of Jesus spent her last days in a small house where a humble chapel now stands. We will continue to Ephesus as we pass through the Magnesian Gate into the most incredible excavation we will see on this trip. We will see the Great Theatre, where St. Paul preached and held crowds of nearly 25,000 people. Next, we travel along the Arcadian Way, walking in the footsteps of Mark Anthony and Cleopatra. You will have free time to explore the beautiful town of Kusadasi before boarding the ship for lunch and heading to Patmos. We will arrive at Skala Harbor with its quaint white houses, shopping, restaurants, and beautiful scenery. This is also where St. John lived in a cave and wrote the book of Revelation. Enjoy dinner and overnight onboard the ship as we sail on to Crete.

DAY 10 March 24: CRETE / SANTORINI

Today, we will visit the ruins of Knossos, which is a short drive from Heraklion's center. We will see Knossos Palace, incredible Venetian fortresses, museums, and other fine examples of Greek aesthetic architecture. Next, we will have time to shop at the outdoor market before returning to the ship and sailing to Santorini. Arguably the most beautiful of the islands, it is highlighted by a volcanic crater barely submerged in the sea. Santorini is home to many shops and cafes scattered among scenic white houses and rich Greek culture (a guided tour is optional)—dinner & overnight onboard the ship.

DAY 11 March 25: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

You will transfer to the airport this morning to board our return flight home.
